This study presents an investigation of the characteristics of the items and factors which make up Forms 8, 9, and 10 of the Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB). Data on the ASVAB forms were collected from a large sample of applicants for military enlistment at 20 geographically dispersed Armed Forces Examining and Entrance Stations (AFEES). Item and factor analyses were conducted on samples equated in ability through an external reference test, the Armed Forces Qualification Test-7a (AFQT-7a). The true score theory item analyses show the subtests to have relatively easy items in most cases. Item-test biserial correlations are quite high (about .60), indicating subtest internal consistency. In keeping with these indexes, the subtest means are high, and distributions of raw scores are skewed toward the easy range. Subtest scores have high reliability as befits homogeneous groups of items. Item response theory analyses show much the same information with easy items. Relationships of the Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) Forms 8, 9, and 10 to Air Force Technical School Final Grades

The Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB), consisting of 10 subtests, is used as the one multiple test instrument for enlisting young men and women into the military services. The ASVAB Forms 8, 9, and 10 are used by the Air Force to select and classify enlistees into four basic aptitude areas: Mechanical, Administrative, General, and Electronics. The ASVAB also yields a common selection score called the Armed Forces Qualification Test (AFQT).
